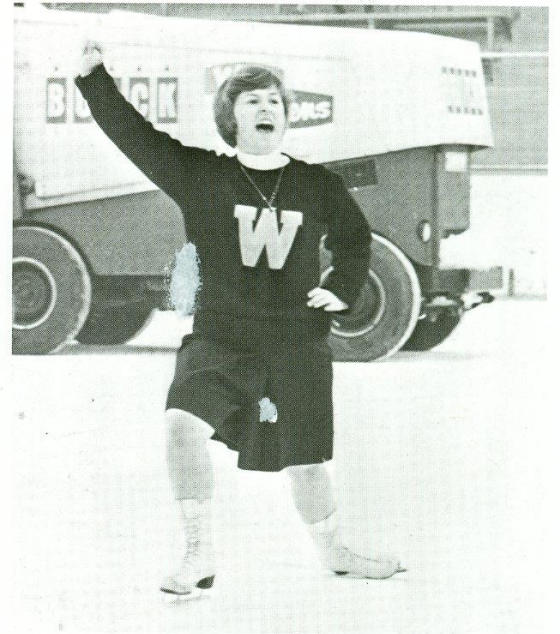

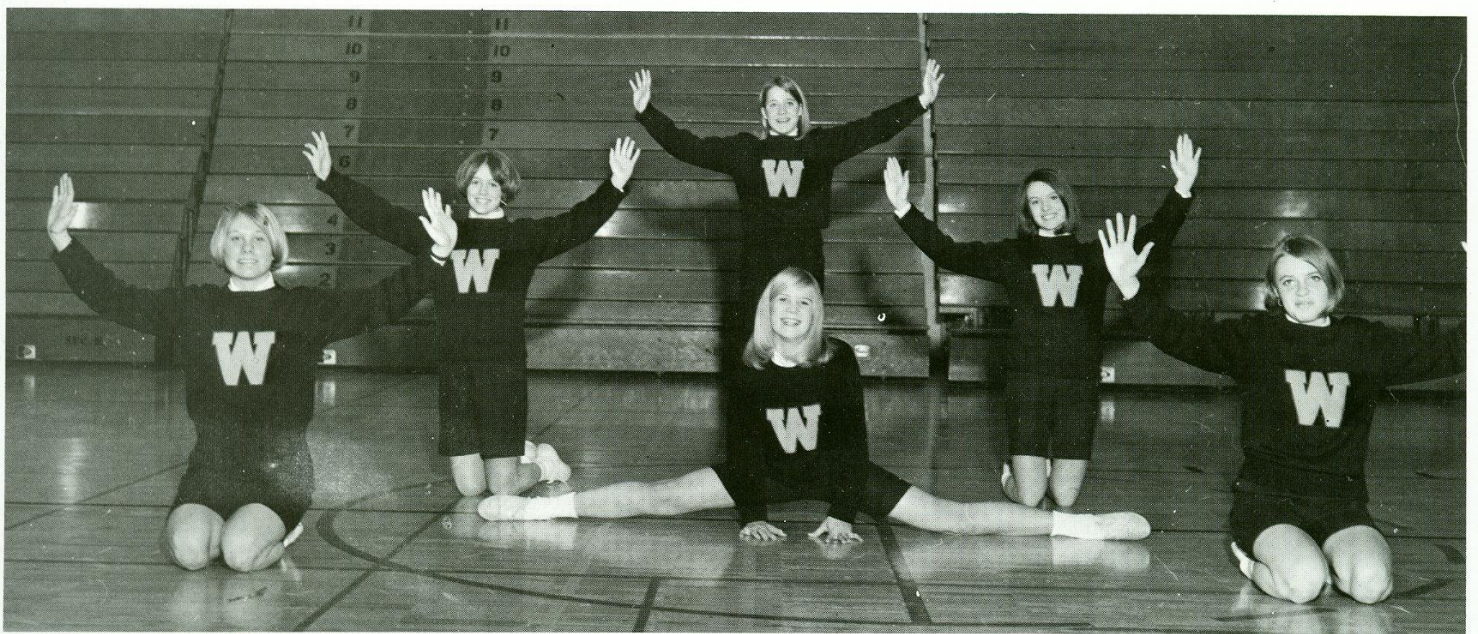


Pixie pleaded for pep.
